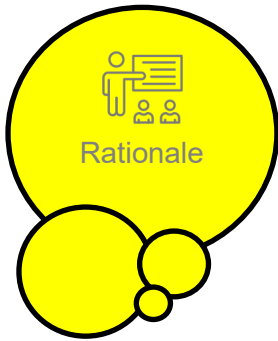




Class Charts is Dane Court Grammar's new behaviour management system, from September. It will be used to monitor student progress, providing live updates on positive and negative situations which have occurred. You will also receive regular behaviour intelligence updates from the school's pastoral team, keeping you fully informed on school life.



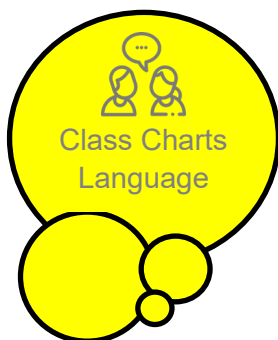
Class Charts will allow us to do the following:

- Improve our engagement with you, with live reporting and increased contact.
- Create proactive behaviour strategies for the classroom.
- Allow us to maintain our high expectation on levels for behaviour.
- Give a balanced picture of positive and negative behaviours.



As parents / carers you will receive the following **reports**:

- Real time notifications, including positive and negative behaviour incidents.
- Information regarding detentions.
- Contact from Teachers, Year Leads and the Senior Leadership Team regarding any high level positive successes or behaviour issues.



Contact with the parents / carers will be as follows:

- Positive behaviours will be recorded based on students demonstrating our core values of caring, open-minded and principled, as well as showing excellent academic progress, engagement and extra-curricular involvement.
- Negative behaviours will fall under 2 categories: B1 - which will be issued for low level behaviours that do not meet our expectations for behaviour; B2 - which will be issued for continued low level behaviours or significant immediate behaviours that require SLT or Year Lead intervention.



To sign up to Class Charts you will need to do the following:

- Within the first two weeks of term, you will receive an email with a parent login code.
- You will then need to open up **Class Charts** on the internet or via the mobile phone app and follow the sign up instructions ([More Information](#)).
